of durable features—from engineered lumber that resists warping to extremely durable exterior features such as 30-year
shingles to waterproofing foundation walls—helping homeowners save money over the long-term!

A more efficient home

Our homes are resource-efficient, reducing their environmental impact, both during the build and in the day-to-day operation of
the home. Some of the options to choose from include: energy efficiency—furnaces and air conditioners, windows, Energy Star
appliances, etc.; electrical efficiency—Compact Fluorescent Lamps (CFL) and Light-Emitting Diode (LED) to timers and motion
sensors to whole-home automation; and water efficiency—water-saving toilets to low-flow showers and faucets to xeriscaping
